

Stage 5 Textile Competition Art Quilt – Living in Australia in the 21st Century

Judging Criteria:

- ★ Must be students own work
- ★ Demonstrate competence in a variety of textile techniques
- ★ Reflect life in the 21st Century
- ★ No larger than 40cm x 40cm
