



Stage 5 Textile Challenge 2010

Art Quilt – Design Elements

It is not too late to register for the 2010 art quilt challenge. Students are required to make an art quilt no larger than 40cm x 40cm. To create the art quilt students are to use a **maximum of five** of the following design elements to develop an original art quilt.

Students can select from the following:

- Patchwork geometric shapes
- Incorporate the colours of the rainbow
- Use only recycled materials
- Embellish with beads
- Create a design using shiva sticks and rubbing plates
- Add text by hand or machine embroidery
- Use only cotton fabrics
- Appliqué a design
- Add a fabric flower or insect
- Create unusual textures by incorporating a variety of fabrics including velvets and sheers
- Use a monochromatic colour scheme
- Add dimension to the art quilt by using Pellon and hand or machine quilting
- Add different size buttons
- Create lines by couching yarns
- Incorporate a digital image
- Use an innovative technique like solvy or Tyvek
- Incorporate a hand felted shape
- Add a decorative braid
- Incorporate fabrics which are black, grey and white
- Use an embellishing machine



The competition will close on Friday 24th September 2010. The art quilts must have the student details and art quilt information securely attached to the back of the quilt. Please include the full name of the student as this information will be used on the certificate.

Winning entries will be displayed at Texstyle exhibitions during 2010 -2011. These art quilts will not be returned to students until August 2011, unless requested.

Maximum of 2 entries per school can be entered.

Judging Criteria:

- ★ Must be students own work
- ★ Demonstrate competence in a variety of textile techniques
- ★ Incorporate a maximum of five design elements
- ★ No larger than 40cm x 40cm
- ★ Provide a 100 word description of art quilt identifying the design elements and how they have been used effectively to create a design.

The student who creates the winning art quilt will receive an embellishing machine donated by Blessington Group Australia. 2nd and 3rd prize will be donated by S & S Creativity Unlimited.
