



## ***Texstyle 2010 – 11***

During 2010 – 2011 Texstyle will be on exhibition at a number of venues both in the Sydney as well as regional locations. The only venue where the complete exhibition can be viewed is at the Teachers Federation Conference Centre. Smaller exhibitions will be displayed at the Craft Expo in Newcastle February 2011, Craft and Quilt Fair in Sydney June 2011 and Canberra August 2011. There will also be Connected Classroom presentations where schools from around the state can participate.

The ***Sydney Texstyle exhibition*** will open on **Monday 29<sup>th</sup> November and run till Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> December** at the NSW Teachers Federation Conference Centre, 37 Reservoir St, Surry Hills. The conference centre is a 3 minute walk from Central railway.

## ***Student Program***

### **Year 12 Major Textile Project**

**9.45am – 11.45am Mon 29<sup>th</sup> November – Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> December**

**12.15pm – 2.15pm Mon 29<sup>th</sup> November – Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> December**

These seminars are presented by textile teachers who have HSC practical marking experience. Students will gain valuable information about both the textile item and the supporting documentation to maximise their results in the HSC. During the two hour seminar students will also have time to view the exhibition to complete an information sheet. Question time with the presenter will allow students to clarify their MTP ideas. Each student will receive an information booklet. Cost \$15 per student for TEA member schools and \$18 per student non member schools. 1 teacher admitted free for each 15 students.

**Schools can also book student groups in to view the exhibition.**

Cost is \$5 per student and teachers, no charge for exhibition viewing if attending a workshop.

**Bookings are essential to ensure there is adequate space for all students to view the exhibition.**

## **Hands on Textile Workshops**

**Students in Stage 5 or 6 Textiles may attend these workshops**

### **Whitehouse Institute of Design Rendering Workshop**

**9.45am – 11.45am Mon 29<sup>th</sup> November – Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> December**

**12.15pm – 2.15pm Mon 29<sup>th</sup> November – Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> December**

Students will experiment with a variety of rendering techniques and how to represent fabrics through mixed media, including coloured pencils, watercolour pencils, pens and professional markers. Students will render images from the five focus areas – apparel, costume, textile arts, furnishings and non apparel.

Cost \$10 per student and teacher for TEA member schools and \$12 per student and teacher non member schools. **Max: 25 students per workshop**

### **Shibori – Sylvia Riley**

**9.45am – 11.45am Mon 29<sup>th</sup> November – Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> December**

**12.15pm – 2.15pm Mon 29<sup>th</sup> November – Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> December**

In this workshop students will manipulate silk and cotton fabric using shibori techniques. Sylvia will demonstrate the techniques and then students will complete samples. Direct dyes will be used. Notes will be supplied; **students need to bring an old towel and an apron.**

During the workshop students will have the opportunity to discuss with Sylvia their MTP project and seek advice on the best dyeing techniques for their chosen project.

Cost \$10 per student and teacher for TEA member schools and \$12 per student and teacher non member schools. **Max: 20 students per workshop**

#### **Creative Techniques in colouring a silk scarf**

This is an ideal workshop for students to experiment with fabric dyeing and printing. During this workshop students will colour a silk scarf using a variety of techniques with Maimeri Idea fabric colour, Jacquard Dye-Na-Flow, Silk Salt, Shiva Oilsticks, Jacquard Tie Dye Kit and Cedar Canyon rubbing plates. The scarf can be taken home and embellished with creative stitching.

Cost \$10 per student and teacher for TEA member schools and \$12 per student and teacher non member schools. **Max: 20 students per workshop**

#### **Working with Synthetic Fabrics Workshop**

**9.45am – 11.45am Tues 30<sup>th</sup> November, Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> December**

**12.15pm – 2.15pm Tues 30<sup>th</sup> November, Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> December**

Students learn various techniques in the heat manipulation of synthetic fabrics by taking advantage of their thermoplasticity. Inspiration and ideas for the use of these techniques in the construction of projects will be discussed. Each student will produce at least three samples from the workshop.

Cost \$10 per student and teacher for TEA member schools and \$12 per student and teacher non member schools. **Max: 20 students per workshop**
