## ***Texstyle 2012***

During 2012 Texstyle will be on exhibition at a number of venues both in the Sydney as well as regional locations. The only venue where the complete exhibition can be viewed is at the Muse, Sydney Institute of Technology, Ultimo. Smaller exhibitions will be displayed at the Powerhouse Museum, Craft & Sewing Show Rosehill Racecourse March 2012, Craft and Quilt Fair in Sydney June 2012 and Canberra and Newcastle August 2012. This year Texstyle will also collaborating with Design Tech, in an inaugural show at the Albury Regional Gallery in May.

The ***Sydney Texstyle exhibition*** will open on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> February and run till Saturday 3<sup>th</sup> March at The Muse Sydney Institute of Technology Ultimo, TAFE. The Muse is a 5 minute walk from Central railway station. The Powerhouse Museum at this time will be showcasing Design Tec and Love Lace exhibition, there will three Texstyle garments on show as part of the Design Tec showcase. The Powerhouse is a two minute walk from The Muse.

## ***Student Program***

Seminars are presented by textile teachers who have HSC practical marking experience. Students will gain valuable information about both the textile item and portfolio, this year focusing on the last two sections of supporting documentation as to maximise their results in the HSC. During the two-hour seminar students will also have time to view the exhibition and complete an information sheet. Question time with the presenter will allow students to clarify their MTP ideas. Each student will receive an information booklet. Cost \$15 per student for TEA member schools and \$18 per student non member schools. 1 teacher admitted free for each 15 students.

### **Schools can also book student groups into view the exhibition.**

Cost is \$5 per student and teachers, no charge for exhibition viewing if attending a workshop.

**Bookings are essential to ensure there is adequate space for all students to view the exhibition.**
